## Revolving Door Effect

What is this?

An official who has exercised supervision over a private company starts working at the company after quitting his or her job in public service. For instance, a situation where an official omits to issue an injunction to a private company, in return getting a job at the company. Also see Conflict of Interest. Also see the Civil Service Act §60(5) that prohibits officials from working for an employer (being a management body member, holding a share, etc.) over which he or she has exercised supervision.
